TIPS & TRICKS

Start small!

01.

- Pick 1 skill or lesson to "transform".
- Use pre-made task cards & activities.
- Then pick a theme YOU enjoy to tie it to.

02.

- STUDENTS being engaged!
- Bringing learning to life!
- Kids buying into their learning!

03.

Get a co-worker or your team to do it with you! At the very least you can learn, laugh, and vent with someone in the process!

04.

Give yourself grace & know it won't be perfect. That's ok!

- Use what you already have or borrow!
- If you need to buy things, give yourself a small budget (\$20-30).
- Shop at Dollar stores, thrift shops, etc.

- Think to yourself "why did I start this" as you look around and don't see it coming together quickly. Be patient.
